
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
Brief Report


Brief Report on Education survey:

Date: 3/1/2022

On the occasion of Savitribai Phule, Jayanti Women cell in collaboration with NSS organized Educational Survey in Adopted Village Inderwada, on 3rd January 2022. The purpose of this survey was to spread awareness among village people about the importance of education especially the importance of girl's/women education.

Savitribai Phule was the first female teacher in India; she is also known as the revolutionary feminist icon who aids emphasis on educating women and along with her husband, Jyoti Rao Phule, she opened the first school for girls in India. To give tribute to her on her Birth Anniversary Women cell and NSS carried out Education Survey at Inderwada village which has a special emphasis on women's education it has a questionnaire that includes the total number of women in the family, their level of education primary/ secondary or higher education, what do they do, whether they want to carry forward their education or not, etc. The education survey concludes some findings that some of them are unable to continue their higher education because of some economic crisis but now they want to continue women cell executive members along with students aware them of policies of higher education, part-time education, and Mukta Vidyapeeth. Students share their thoughts on education with villagers to motivate them for higher studies. Students also aware villagers about the great work of Savitribai Phule
