## > NSS AND SOCIAL OUTREACH

National Service Scheme (NSS) was launched in 1969 to celebrate the birth centenary of Mahatma Gandhi, father of the nation with the prime objective of education through service. It also facilitates the personality development of students through social and community service. The aim and objective of the NSS cell of our college is to work among people, serve the weaker section of the community and acquire the skill of participative leadership. NSS unit serves society by organizing numerous activities under the campaign as well as through programmes. The activities such as manual work, working with welfare institutes, awareness work on the ban of plastic, AIDS diseases, Blood donation, Anti-superstition, Water conservation, Cleanliness drive, Tree plantation etc. Every participating student volunteer has to devote 120 hours in one academic year. University-level camps, Inter-college programmes are organized at various places. In the process of hosting a variety of programmes and engaging in work with other welfare organizations, participating students are empowered with organizational skills, to get exposure to build leadership skills and national service.

The students of our college and other institutes have the opportunity to participate in social services by enrolling in NSS.
