

INDIA'S POTENTIAL AS TEXTILE SOURCING HUB FOR GLOBAL BRANDS

India enjoys a unique advantage of having abundant raw materials and presence of manufacturing in all segments of the textile value chain but it's yet to become the most favored destination for sourcing by International Brands. The Textile & Apparel industry is one of the largest and the most important sectors for the Indian economy in terms of output, foreign exchange earnings and employment. It also provides decent employment to over 45 million people and is the second largest provider of employment after agriculture. As per the WTO in its World Trade Statistical Review 2018, India is ranked as the largest exporter of Ready Made Garments (RMG) in the world. Given that Ready Made Garments manufacturing units can be setup at all sites across, particularly because of low cost of power and resources, the unit range from small to large. Consequently, the RMG sector continues to be dominated by its unorganized players. However, the



of cotton in the world, India is also the leading consumer of cotton. Domestic Textile and apparel industry contributes 2% to India's GDP and accounts for 5% of industrial production, 21% of the country's foreign exchange earnings and 12% of country's export earnings with huge potential to grow. This sector is all the more important because it is dominated by women workers, with 70% of the workforce being women. To me this is a big sector which can uplift rural women from abject poverty and also open up the opportunities for the large number of India. If we look closely, the Indian textile and apparel sector, the sub-sectors of spinning, processing and garmenting are fragmented and lacking the requisite scale for success in global markets. Most of the manufacturing units have small capacities and low manufacturing efficiencies which makes it difficult for them to compete in global markets.

The diversified power textile and trading sector forms the largest section of the textile sector. The major sub-sectors that comprise the textile sector include the organized, unorganized, fiber, textile and leather. The organized fiber, textile and leather

industry, the petrochemical and allied textile industry, handicrafts, the jute & jute textiles industry and leather exports. As per the CSO, Indian textile industry is one of the largest in the world with a large research base and manufacturing strength across the value chain. India is the largest

Amrit Kaal Budget 2023 Provides Roadmap for India to Become \$5 Trillion Economy

The Union Finance Minister, Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman, presented the Budget for 2023-24 to the Parliament on 1 February. The budget is an outstanding effort that embodies an inclusive growth strategy with an eye toward the future. In the coming years, growth and consumption will be driven by a dual emphasis: higher capital expenditures for infrastructure development and tax breaks for the middle class.

In an anticipated 7% GDP growth in 2023, the first budget of the 'Amrit Kaal' has set the stage for the economy. The growth scenario for the remaining financial year and succeeding ones. The Budget provides a road map for achieving India's aspirations and ambitions as the nation embarks on its journey towards India 2047. To ensure a generation and rural commitment to the budget, the Union Budget 2023 has ushered a number of substantial measures with a view to making India a part of the massive global slowdown caused by the pandemic and the war. The budget has recognized India as a point of growth for the current year, which is estimated at 7.0%, the highest among all major economies. The income per capita has increased to Rs 1.97 lakh in the past nine years. India's economy has risen from the tenth to the fifth largest in the world. In addition, the Finance Minister has made an extraordinary effort to adhere to fiscal prudence and has indicated a path to let go from 4.5% by FY25/26, much to the industry's comfort. By achieving a fiscal deficit of 6.4% for FY23 and maintaining market borrowing at Rs 16.45 trillion with an estimated fiscal deficit of 5.9% for FY24, the budget has addressed one of the most pressing issues.

The vision of the budget for the Amrit Kaal includes a pro-growthmen and knowledge-based economy with robust public finances and a robust financial sector, and must be achieved. Jan Bhagidari through Sabka Saath Sabka Prayagraj is necessary. Finance Minister also added that the economic agenda for achieving this vision focuses on three things: providing ample opportunities for citizens, especially the youth, to realize their aspirations, fostering growth and job creation, and bolstering macroeconomic stability.

ECONOMIC SURVEY 2022-23 Highlights

STATE OF THE ECONOMY 2022-23
India's GDP growth is expected to remain robust in FY24, with GDP forecast in the range of 6.6-8%. Private consumption in first half of FY23 was highest since FY15 and this has led to a boost in production activity resulting in enhanced capacity utilization across sectors.

OUTLOOK 2023-24
The Capital Expenditure of Central Government increased by 63.4 per cent in the first eight months of FY23. MSME sector witnessed a growth rate of over 30.6% on average during Jan-Nov 2022. Retail inflation was back within RBI's target range in November 2022. Indian Rupee performed well compared to other Emerging Market Economies in Apr-Dec 2022. Direct Tax collections for the period April-November 2022 remain buoyant. The year witnessed enhanced employment generation with declining urban unemployment rate.

INTEGRAL TO INDIA

Inaugurating the International Dairy Federation, World Dairy Summit (IDF-WDS) at Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh, in September 2022, Prime Minister Narendra Modi underlined the centrality of 'Pishu Dhan' (Livestock) and milk-related business as an intrinsic part of India's cultural landscape. This has accorded the dairy sector of India several unique characteristics.

JOBS IN TODAY'S TECH-DRIVEN DAIRY INDUSTRY

Dairy is a significant agri-business in India, with a large portion of the sector (around 35%) being organised. India's dairy industry has been fairly successful in delivering multiple development goals crucial for the economy, such as improving farmers' livelihoods, creating jobs, supporting agricultural industrialisation and commercialisation, and enhancing nutrition for the masses. India's dairy ecosystem includes a variety of players, such as small and large-scale farmers, cooperatives, private dairies, aggregators, milk processing companies, distributors and retailers. The government plays a significant role in the sector through policies and programs aimed at supporting farmers and promoting the growth of the industry.

From Farm to Fridge

The dairy supply chain is a complex process that begins on the farm and ends in the fridge. To operate a successful dairy business, it is essential to have a strong team in place. This team is responsible for executing an array of responsibilities ranging from maintaining milk herd health,

The four-day-long IDF WDS-2022, held from 12th to 15th September was a conglomeration of global and Indian dairy stakeholders, that included industry leaders, experts, farmers, and policy planners, who brainstormed around the theme of 'Dairy for Nutrition and Livelihood'.

Around 1,500 participants from 50 countries participated in IDF WDS-2022.

A dairy is a business enterprise established for the harvesting of animal milk, which is obtained mostly from cows or goats, and also from buffalo, sheep, horses and even camels for human consumption.

It is one of the few sectors in the economy with a multiplier effect. It augments the incomes of small-marginalised families across six lakh villages in India. Its sale/export generates employment, improves nutrition, empowers women and is a great tool for equitable growth and income distribution among its owner-entities.

Dairy is an integral part of the Indian economy, rural livelihood, sustainable development, progress, and growth. The potential of the dairy sector not only gives impetus to the rural economy but is also a

expertise in areas such as farm management, veterinary care and nutrition, food processing, food technology, quality control experts, packaging experts, supply chain management, marketing and sales, and engineers and technicians for operation and maintenance of heavy machineries.






